Apply to your year group(s):

- Make the questions suitable for the curriculum you are teaching right now – don't forget to make them progressively harder & add multi-step problems into the mix!

Activity

> Hang questions up around the outdoor space. Order them with numbers in the top left corner. Have an answer sheet for yourself to help you keep pace with the children!

Examples include: Q1) $1 + _ = 10$, Q2) $20 = 11 + _$, Q3) If $9 - _ = 2$ Then $90 - _ = 20$, Q4) Mrs Brown needs 100 acorns. She says I have some acorns but I need 60 more. How many acorns does she have?

> Children take a mini whiteboard or clipboard and begin with the first question. They record the question number in the top left corner of their whiteboard.

> Children work out the answer using any equipment you have provided from the classroom or mentally.

> They then visit you to show you their whiteboard. You give them a thumbs up if the answer is correct and they move on to the next question. A thumbs down means they need to try again. If children keep on getting a thumbs down put them in a group together, to support one another with a few helpful hints from you.
